



Cut the dust boot 20 mm from the lower end.

Assemble the strut/shock absorber, see figure 2

Set the installation dimensions according to figure 3. You may need to change these to reach the target height.

Note!

After you have installed all shock absorbers/ struts you must check and adjust height. See section Adjustments and Setup data.

Install the Öhlins strut on the vehicle according to the vehicle service manual.

Caution!

Ensure that all screws are tightened to the correct torque and that nothing fouls or restricts movement of the strut/shock absorber when the suspension is fully compressed or extended.

Note!

Make sure that all removed parts, except the replaced parts, are reinstalled in the same positions as they were before the installation of the Öhlins shock absorbers.

ADJUSTMENTS

Before riding, always make sure that the basic settings made by Öhlins are according to recommended Setup Data. Read about adjustments and setting up in the Öhlins Owner's Manual before you make any adjustments. Contact an Öhlins dealer if you have any questions about setting up.
